Kurt Hoffman explained the plans for septic system alteration with no expansion and why the four waivers are requested. It's a small lot, location of well and very steep slope.

The proposed disposal bed does not meet the 100 foot setback to the existing well, or the neighbor's well, Lot 30. The proposed septic system does not meet the minimum separation distance of 50 feet from the neighbor's existing septic system, Lot 30. The proposed disposal bed does not meet the minimum 25 foot setback requirement, per state code, from the existing dwelling.
