

BOARD OF HEALTH
October 13, 2022

On Thursday, October 13, 2022, at 7:31 P.M., the regularly scheduled meeting of the Holland Township Board of Health was held in the meeting room at the Municipal Building, 61 Church Road.

Before the meeting was opened, the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson, Audrey Balogh, and the following statement was read at the commencement of the meeting.

A township resident was bitten on the leg by a German shepherd dog that ran out and bit him. The resident was on his daily run.

Confinement required for 10 days.
