Minutes

Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM

Other Business

- **Upcoming Events** – Larry LaFevre discussed the following:
 - “History Bowl”, September 22nd, sponsored by the Hunterdon County 305th – Carl Molter said that he signed up to participate.
 - “Hunterdon County Community Day”, June 1st – this Commission does not plan to participate.
 - “Hunterdon County 4H and Agricultural Fair”, August 21st – 25th, some 4-hour timeslots are still available on Wednesday and Thursday. Carl plans to attend and Joe Becker has expressed interest. (Participation to be scheduled.)
 - “Holland Farmer’s Market” – this Commission does not plan to participate.

Highlands Council Grant

Larry said he sent out information about the Highlands Council Grant, asking for suggested projects. If eligible, the grant can be as high as \$50,000. He discussed applying for funding to digitize the Frank Stull slides. Another potential project is to repair and move the 4-square schoolhouse, currently on private property, to a new location to be selected. (Carla Cielo prepared a feasibility study for relocation dated October 2012.)

Larry spoke about hosting a slide presentation about the history of Riegel Paper on behalf of the Milford Borough Historical Society. Proposed location is The Ship Inn at Milford. If the event is scheduled, Carl volunteered to narrate. Larry showed a considerable collection of slides in boxes that contain carousels, binders and some narratives.
