WHEREAS, the Local Unit Technology Pilot Program and Study Act (P.L. 2001, c. 30) authorizes the sale of surplus personal property no longer needed for public use through an online auction service; and

-RESOLUTION--Approval of Mutual Aid Agreement for Fire Service

RESOLUTION

Adopting a Form Mutual Aid Assistance Agreement for the Holland Township Volunteer Fire Company

WHEREAS, mutual aid and assistance agreements between municipalities, counties, law enforcement agencies, police, fire departments, EMS organizations and Fire Districts are permitted pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A: 14-26 and 40A: 14-156.1; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be in the best interests of the residents of this municipality to facilitate entrance into mutual aid and assistance agreement with other municipalities and their fire departments to provide additional protection against loss, damage or destruction by fire, catastrophe, civil unrest, major emergency or other extraordinary devastation damage or destruction to person and property, in those situations when outside aid and assistance is needed; and

WHEREAS, in consultation with the Chief of the Holland Township Volunteer Fire Company, Inc., the Township Committee has developed a form mutual aid agreement, which is attached hereto, in order to facilitate entrance into such mutual aid agreements; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent that the Holland Township Volunteer Fire Company, Inc. and its representatives may use such form agreement to negotiate entry into mutual aid relationships with other municipal fire departments; and

WHEREAS, it is also the understanding that and intent of the Township Committee that the Township Committee shall approved by resolution the entrance into mutual aid agreements with individual fire departments; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Holland, County of Holland and State of New Jersey as follows:

- A. That the attached form Mutual Aid Agreement is hereby adopted and approved.
- B. That separate approval shall be required to be granted by the Township Committee in order to enter into a mutual aid agreement with a specific and particular fire department.
