Authorizing Holland Township Support of the Sustainable Jersey<sup>TM</sup> Grant Application for The Hunterdon Art Tour (THAT)

**WHEREAS**, Holland Township is participating in the Sustainable Jersey<sup>™</sup> Program, is a Certified Municipality and established the Hunterdon Creative Team in September 2016, and

**WHEREAS,** The Hunterdon Art Tour (THAT) was formed in 2016 by a dedicated group of artists, art lovers and longtime Hunterdon County residents to support and administer an annual driving tour of artists' studios within Hunterdon County, with a vision toward elevating the county's cultural profile, and

WHEREAS, THAT hosted open community meetings and confirmed the support of local organizations (River Union Stage, ArtYard, Hunterdon Art Museum and Hunterdon County Cultural & Heritage Commission) to help build awareness of the artists' studio tour, to engage potential participants and partners and to promote the 2017 tour, and

**WHEREAS,** THAT is working to secure funding for the 2018 tour to make progress toward its goals of becoming THE signature event to promote Hunterdon County as an arts destination; to build community among artists, arts and community organizations, schools and businesses; and to strengthen existing partnerships and forge new connections across 26 municipalities to recognize and celebrate Hunterdon County's bountiful and diverse cultural assets, and

**WHEREAS**, the residents of Holland Township can benefit from its enthusiastic support of the arts by creating a cooperative climate (among the 26 municipalities in Hunterdon County) to further creative endeavors, welcome the current trends in the arts, provide a venue for artists to share their visions and bring the larger art world into our community, and

WHEREAS, one of the purposes of the Sustainable Jersey<sup>™</sup> Program is to provide resources to municipalities to make progress on sustainability issues, and they have created a grant program called the Sustainable Jersey Small Grants Program, and

WHEREAS, The Hunterdon Art Tour (THAT), has expressed an interest in submitting a grant application to the Sustainable Jersey<sup>TM</sup> Small Grants Program for an award of \$20,000 in support of its 2018 Artists' Studio Tour, which will fulfill the Sustainable Jersey<sup>TM</sup> Action "Utilizing Your Creative Assets" and provide a valuable contribution to Holland Township's efforts to maintain and advance its Sustainable Jersey<sup>TM</sup> certification, a prestigious designation for municipal governments in New Jersey, and
