NEW BUSINESS FROM TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE

-Authorization for the Mayor and Municipal Clerk to sign a contract for 2018 and 2019 Animal Control Services:

In 2017 the Township contracted with Animal Control & Investigative Services, LLC (signed 12/10/16) for an annual cost of \$9,200. Including all certified officers, vehicles, fuel, insurance and equipment. The proposal eliminated additional charges for stray animal holding. On March 7, 2017 the Committee then approved St. Hubert’s to be assigned our animal control responsibilities effective February 28, 2017 at the contractually obligated service rate for the remainder of 2017 because Animal Control & Investigative Service dissolved due to personal issues.

St. Hubert’s is proposing a two year contract 1/1/18-12/31/19 with all-inclusive services for \$15,873. (\$7937.00 per year)

Mr. Scheibener moved and Mr. Krov seconded the motion to authorize the Mayor and Municipal Clerk to sign a two year contract (1/1/2018-12/31/2019) with St. Hubert’s at the proposed price.
