• 2022 Reorganization

All members present signed 'Oath of Allegiance and Office' form.

- November minutes were approved as submitted.
- Farmland Preservation Applications:

**Braun** (B15 L2, 112ac and B15 L22.01, 15ac): DE program. CMV=\$3500/ac., 5-acre severable exception. Closed 12/22/21.

**Rolph (Cernecaro)** (B17 L19, 91 net ac): CMV=\$4100/ac. Closing review in progress. Estate issue. **Schafer**/Cummins (B6 L62.03, 20.99ac): Received Green Light approval from SADC on 11/7/21. HLT will apply for ACEP-ALE (Fed) funding and order appraisals and a survey. The Twp. Committee via resolution agreed to reimburse HLT for the technical costs. If the farm is preserved, the SADC will hold the easement.

- Annual PIG Application Review and Update: Christine sent to SADC on Dec 10<sup>th</sup>.
- Other Land Preservation or Business:

Preserved Nemeth Farm in Everittstown (~100 acres) sold for \$1.2M at public auction. Purchased by a New York podiatrist as a weekend home.

GenOn / Osakame Park Hunting - Larry to follow up with Mayor Dan Bush to ask whether or not hunting is permitted on Sundays.

Gravel Hill / John Oliver Property – 'For Sale' signs were taken down, as Township is interested in purchasing the property. Larry will ask Mayor Bush for an update.

Gravel Hill / Ken Harrison Lot – Larry received a call from Mr. Ken Harrison who is planning to sell a 12- acre wood lot in Gravel Hill. Green Acres may be interested.

• Pipeline Update:

PennEast in a letter to FERC dated 11/30/21, stated: 'PennEast has ceased all further development of the Project.' However, still awaiting clear direction from the SADC regarding properties near the proposed PennEast pipeline.
